

Allaah created the jinn and mankind

To worship Him alone (and none else)

Loving Allaah (i.e. for everything He gives us everyday and the favors He constantly bestows upon us),

fear of Allaah (i.e. His punishment for our sins), Invocation (dua), Salaah, Fasting, and Doing good to our parents





The most important thing that Allaah has commanded us with is Tawheed (true monotheism) and that is: to worship Allaah only

Translator's Note: While the Christians and Jews claim to be monotheistic, in reality they worship many others along with their Creator including (but not limited to): Ezra, Jesus, Mary, the "holy spirit" (or "holy ghost"), righteous people (like the Prophets), dead people (like saints), as well as their rabbis and priests who claim that things are halaal and haraam in contradiction to the revelation that was sent down (see 9:31). In reality, the Muslim is the only one who worships his Creator alone, not worshiping anything with Him.


